Mount Calvary brings forward the Oxford Movement principles of reverent worship, orthodox faith, and missional service. As a *new* Oxford Movement, we ask God to use this charism to fill a void in our world, and so build his Kingdom both in our time and for eternity.

This means :

Christ is lifted up in our **worship.**

- *Our worship is reverent*, as befits a true encounter with Christ our Lord. This includes Mass celebrated *ad-orientem* and a liturgy in the poetic cadence of Prayerbook English.
- We bring forward the *roots of the faith with newness and vitality*, which includes re-exposing the faithful to the beauty of the Church's tradition of liturgy and music.

Christ is lifted up in his **Word.**

- *All our teaching is grounded in Scripture and the Magisterium in the Tradition of the Fathers and Saints who form our faith.*
- We challenge adults and youth to apply the gospel to every aspect of life, and we *form children* at their unique place of appreciation and understanding.

Christ is lifted up in our **community.**

- *We build one another up in fellowship.*
- Deep relationships among members makes the Body of Christ a supportive reality in all of life.
- We bring the beauty of holiness outside our doors. This begins in our corner of Baltimore and extends to wherever we work and live.
